RULING

Based on the information before the court it appears that the best interests of the parties' minor child, Rebecca, born April 10, 2003, will be served by the court adopting the recommendations of Family Court Services in their report issued on May 9, 2018. The court will do so and therefore declines to modify the existing parenting plan. The court expects the parties to be flexible about accommodating Becca's preferences and her schedule.

The court has no jurisdiction to entertain Petitioner/Father's Request for Order (RFO), to the extent it seeks orders re child support add-ons, because Father failed to furnish the court with a current Income and Expense Declaration (FL-150), in contravention of MCR Fam 6.13 and 6.14, and CRC 5.427.

Mother's counter-requests for attorney's fees and for a bonus schedule are not properly before the court on Father's RFO (Family Code (FC) §213).
