- I. Call to Order and introductions
 - A. Commissioners present: Don, Belinda, Noah, Dana, Laily (phone) and Gerald (phone)
 - B. Commissioners absent: Marissa and Marilyn

- II. Review and Approve October and November 2015 Minutes

Don motioned to approve both the October and November minutes. Noah seconded.

- III. Juvenile Hall
 - A. State report

The Juvenile Hall Inspection report was submitted to the State.

 - B. Next steps, areas of focus, meetings
 - i. Areas of follow up include:
 - A. Evidence-based NA/AA programs. Don will follow up and share information regarding best practices and evidence-based harm reduction programs with Angela and Matt.
 - B. Food. The Commission will share local food resources (including Judy Schill and company) with Matt.
 - C. Education. Dana, Marilyn and Laily will follow up with Lisa regarding education improvements at the Hall.

- IV. Ongoing involvement, opportunities and activities
 - A. Juvenile Hall/services stakeholder meetings
 - i. There will be a series of meetings, including different stakeholders, providers, the public and neighbors during this year. Dana and Don are on the planning team. The first meeting, with key law enforcement and school representatives will be on February 26th.

 - B. Youth Officers Roundtable
 - i. What does this work look like?
 - A. Youth officers, including school resource officers, from throughout Marin will meet to connect, gain a greater understanding of issues affecting youth in Marin and share information and education regarding restorative justice.
